Lancashire County Council has included resurfacing inlay of Main Street (B5272) from the A588 to Cockerham Road in its 2018/19 highways programme. The cost is £107,876.94. County Councillor Gina Dowding said: *"I know residents will be relieved to hear that the road will be resurfaced. I am now trying to push this up the list to get this done as soon as possible this year, but as Green View goes to print I have no information about dates for the works."*

Questions at Council

There is controversy at county hall as the Conservative ruling group has changed the rules without consultation about how other councillors may ask questions at cabinet meetings. Until March any councillor could turn up and ask a question about agenda items from the floor, but now has to submit them in advance. At Lancaster City Council the Cabinet does not allow back-bench councillors to speak at all unless it is on an issue in their ward. Green councillors are asking for changes via the constitution to remedy this.
